All the J-1 students and scholars need to purchase the required amount of health insurance coverage which is required by the U.S. Immigration Law. Please see the following information, particularly highlighted in yellow: <i>The student (and their family if applicable) must maintain sufficient health insurance as defined by the University and federal guidelines for the entire duration of the student's program. As of May 15, 2015 those requirements are: Medical benefits of at least \$100,000 per accident or illness; repatriation of remains in the amount of \$25,000; medical evacuation in the amount of \$50,000; and deductibles not to exceed \$500 per accident or illness.</i>
